FILM REGISTRATION RULES

The 10th edition of the Brussels International Film Festival (FIFB) will take place from **October 28 to November 01 2025** in Brussels to the delight of lovers of the 7th art.

The theme of the FIFB has changed its theme to become an international travelling festival focused on pan-African cinema.

The FIFB favours unreleased films as well as new generations of filmmakers.

The Brussels International Film Festival offers 3 official competitions :

- The International Competition (Feature and Short Fiction Films)
- The International Competition (Documentary films)
- The youth film competition (films directed by students)

Competition prizes

The FIFB will have the privilege of presenting the following prizes to the nominees:

The Best Actor Award

- The Best Actress Award
- The best film for young people
- The Best Short Film Award
- The Best documentary Award

The Best Director Award

The Best price of the festival

Festival registration requirements:

Any feature-length, medium-length or short film completed after December 1, 2024 can participate in the competition.

The films presented must be Belgian, European or world premieres.

- Registration required via the online form on the www.fifb.be/inscrire_un_film website
- The registration will only be taken into account after receipt of the download link and payment.
- The dialogues of the film in French, in English only for films that are not subtitled.

Registration start date: March 15, 2025

Registration fees:

- For short films (duration less than 15 minutes), the registration is set at 15€
- For long films (duration greater than or equal to 60 minutes), the registration fee is 30€
- For young films (duration less than 15 minutes) registration will be free.

Publications
